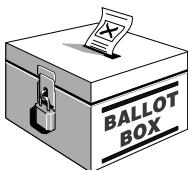

Under Baltimore County law, residents are responsible for keeping the sidewalks, pathways and entrances to their homes clear of snow. The liability for lawsuits rests with the homeowner or renter. Baltimore County only cleans the community streets and alleyways.

**Lockheed Martin Airport Clean Up Meeting**

Lockheed Martin continues to monitor the Hawthorne peninsula and the airport as part of their remedial clean up of the Lockheed property. As part of that process, Lockheed Martin will hold a public information session about the Remedial Action for the Groundwater at Martin State Airport on Wednesday, February 8, at the Marshy Point Nature Center. There will be a poster display and public question and answer session beginning at 5 p.m. with a formal power point presentation at 7 p.m.

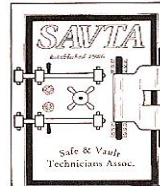
