6259 Days Cove Road, off 11400 block Pulaski Highway, one block east of Allender Road

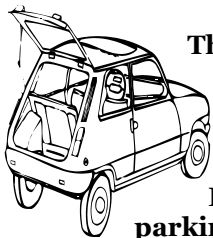

Stakeholder Meeting

The HCA attended the July SWAP meeting which provided information about the Baltimore County Agenda on cleaning up the Middle River/Gunpowder Watershed. Discussed were the present testing and information gathering process, what residents and industry can do to prevent harmful water runoff into our rivers, and reports from Constellation Energy, Aberdeen Proving Ground and the Martin State Airport about present water run-off prevention programs as well as the clean-up of Martin State Airport and other industrial sites in the area.
